Making a €22m switch from Red Bull Salzburg to German Bundesliga side Borussia Dortmund tells the depth of talent of Norwegian international Erling Braut Haaland.

At just 19 years, the young player has become one of the most sought after talents in Europe, with Manchester United and Juventus said to be strong admirers of the Leeds-born player.

As the son of former Leeds United and Manchester City midfielder, Alfie Inge Haaland, the youngster came to the limelight when he scored a first-half hat-trick against Belgian side Genk in September on his UEFA Champions League debut. Since then, Erling has known no stopping as he continues to produce some of the best performances for his club until his big money move to Germany.

His rise may not come as a surprise to many, who have followed him, as the player. He is currently on £100,000 a week wage with his new club. The youngster shocked the world with his nine goals in a single game during the 2019 FIFA Under-20 World Cup in Poland where Norway beat Honduras 12-0.
