

Govt releases GH¢47.13m for 2024 BECE

THE Ministry of Finance has released GH¢47.13 million to the West African Examinations Council (WAEC), giving the council a lease of life

towards the conduct of the 2024 Basic Education Certificate Examination (BECE).

The amount is about half of the GH¢95.83 million the government owed WAEC for fees in the conduct of previous examinations and will enable the examination body to proceed with the BECE to be conducted from Monday, July 8 to Monday, July 15, 2024.

The Minister of State at the Ministry of Finance, Abena Osei-Asare, confirmed this to the *Daily Graphic* last Friday.

The Head of Public Relations of WAEC, John Kapi, also confirmed the release the same day and expressed the hope that given the

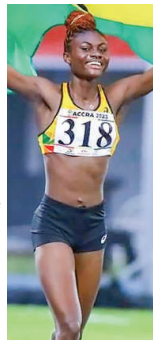
