**A**LL is set for the conduct of Special Voting on Monday, December 2, this year, the Chairperson of the Electoral Commission (EC), Jean Mensa, has stated.

During an interaction with the National Security Task Force, led by the Inspector-General of Police (IGP), Dr George Akufo Dampare, the EC Chairperson said the exercise would take place in 328 special voting centres across the 276 constituencies.
