Outfield turn goalie

BLACK Stars goalkeeper, Lawrence Ati-Zigi, has become the darling boy of most Ghanaians following his sterling performance for the Black Stars during their World Cup game against South Korea last week.

However, prior to the World Cup, the 26-year-old FC St Gallen shot stopper was not considered the favourite for the post until injury sidelined first choice, Joseph Wollacott and his assistant, Richard Ofori.

Ati-Zigi has since seized the opportunity to convince Coach Otto Addo that he could be a strong contender for the role, thereby increasing competition in the Black Stars goalkeeping department at the next Africa Cup of Nations.

The Tamale-born

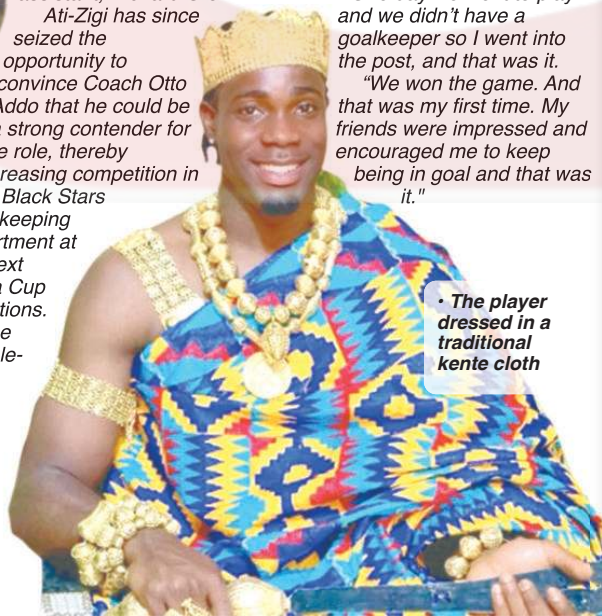
player who represented Ghana at Under-17 and Under-20 levels, has now become a household name but his private life has remained as such as he has kept it away from the public.

"One day we went to play and we didn't have a goalkeeper so I went into the post, and that was it.

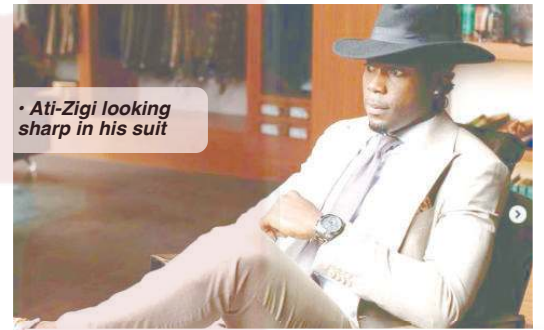
"We won the game. And that was my first time. My friends were impressed and encouraged me to keep being in goal and that was it."



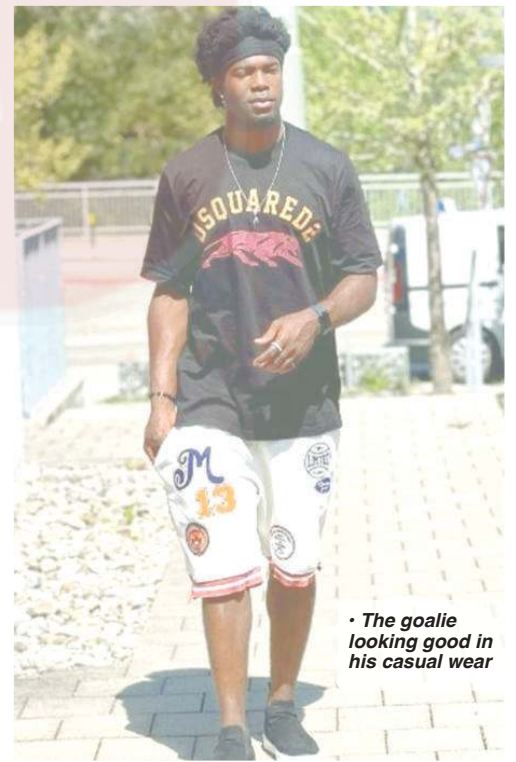
